#### A. BEFORE MEETING

#### 1. General

- a. Remember to always follow applicable County Health Guidelines and up to date Information available at Marinrecovers.com
- b. This plan conforms to the latest guidelines of Marin County Health Dept.
- c. No communal materials i.e. hymnals, outlines, Bibles, writing materials etc. will be distributed.
- d. No offerings will be collected.
- e. No communion will be celebrated at this time.
- f. Service will be shortened to approximately 1 hour.
- g. Plan is for a maximum attendance of 25.
- 2. It's advised that you do not attend if you are "at higher risk for severe illness" (see: cdc.gov/coronavirus). The CDC includes in this category adults 65 years or older, individuals with underlying medical conditions i.e. asthma, HIV, diabetes, obesity, cardiovascular disease and or cancer.

- 3. Do not attend if you have had contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case in the last 21 days.
- 4. It's recommended that you take your temperature before attending. Do not attend if 100.4 degrees or greater. If so, it's recommended to consult your doctor.
- 5. Do not attend if you show any signs of flu like symptoms e.g. fever, recent loss of taste or smell, chills, and/or unusual weakness. If so, it's recommended to consult your doctor.
- 6. It's recommended to wash hands for 20 seconds before the meeting.
- 7. It's recommended that you wash your clothes immediately before and after the meeting.
- 8. It's extremely important to arrive 15 minutes early to facilitate phased entry procedures.
- 9. Onsite touch-less hand sanitizers will be available for before, during and after the service.
- 10. A face covering is required at all times.

- 11. Abstain from all physical contact and greetings like shaking hands or hugging.
- 12. Social Distancing of a minimum of 6 ft is required at all times.
- 13. Plan eating and drinking before the meeting. Use home bathroom before departure as a monitored bathroom will be available for health or emergency use only.
- 14. Parking will be directed by an usher. Again, please arrive 15 minutes early.
- 15. Bring your Bible.
- 16. Please contact the Pastor if you have questions.

#### **B. ARRIVAL AND DURING MEETING:**

- 1. Immediately before entering the service, wait at floor markings.
- 2. All attendees will have their temperatures taken with a touch-less thermometer. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater cannot attend and will be directed to immediately contact their doctor and inform Pastor of result.

- 3. All participants are required to wear face coverings at all times. If needed, they will be supplied.
- 4. Remember not to touch your face, mouth or nose.
- 5. Abstain from all physical contact and greetings like shaking hands or hugging.
- 6. Social Distancing of a minimum of 6 ft is required at all times.
- 7. Ushers will greet attendees with instructions and directions.
- 8. Follow all informational and directional signs.
- 9. Family groups must remain together at all times. Ushers will accommodate seating for this.
- 10. Small children 0-5 years old cannot attend at this time. A nursery will not be available.
- 11. Ushers will direct all attendees to/from their seat(s).
- 12. Chairs will be sanitized per CDC guidelines before and after each meeting.
- 13. Remain seated at all times unless there are health issues or an emergency.
  - 14. Except for family groups, all seating will be a minimum of 6ft apart in all directions.

- 15. Unless for health needs or an emergency, attendees will be asked to remain seated until dismissed in a phased exit.
- 16. If needed, Entry/Exit foot traffic flows will be marked.
- 17. One bathroom will be available for health or emergency use only. Bathroom will be sanitized per CDC guidance after each use by a monitor.
- 18. Do not exchange anything with one another. Take everything home that you came with.
- 19. Bring your Bible.
- 20. Use supplied, Touch-less hand sanitizers.
- 21. Please self-police your surroundings to conform to these guidelines.
- 22. Please immediately bring any suggestions for improved health protections or failures to the Pastor's or usher's attention. We all want to watch out for each other.

### C. AFTER MEETING/DEPARTURE:

- 1. Pastor will review exit and car departure protocols.
- 2. Attendees are required to wear face coverings at all times.

- 3. Abstain from all physical contact and greetings like shaking hands or hugging.
- 4. Social Distancing of a minimum of 6 ft will be required at all times.
- 5. Use supplied touch-less hand sanitizers.
- 6. Use waste container at exit for any disposals.
- 7. Ushers will direct a phased, orderly seating exit. Take everything with you that you came with.
- 8. Remember to always keep 6ft Social Distancing.
- 9. Following the service, leave directly to your car without congregating.
- 10. Ushers will direct car departures.
- 11. Upon arrival at home, it's recommended that you immediately wash your hands for 20 seconds and wash clothes worn during service.
- 12. Please bring any suggestions for improved health protection or disregard of these health guidelines to the Pastor. We all want to watch out for each other.

- 13. It's recommended that you contact your doctor if you experience any flu-like symptoms. Please inform Pastor of results.
